Expert's written consent to participate in the service

Written consent is an **email** that the **expert has sent to the company's contact person** or directly to the EAS contact person with the following content:

1. I confirm that I am aware of the service and agree to participate as an expert for the company .../name of the applying company/... in the EAS international expert service.
2. I confirm that I have familiarized myself with the terms of the service and the tasks assigned to me.
3. I confirm that I meet the minimum requirements set for the product development or export expert in the service:
 - Minimum requirements for a product development expert: At least 36 months of work experience in product development in a direct role related to product development, such as a product development expert, engineer, architect, designer, design manager, or other related position in the target market (according to the company's chosen target market), within the last 60 months from the confirmation of the company in the service.
 - Minimum requirements for an export expert: At least 36 months of work experience in a position related to export development, such as an export manager, sales manager, or similar role in the target market (according to the company's chosen target market), within the last 60 months from the confirmation of the company in the service.
4. I confirm that I am not in a contractual relationship with the participating company during the use of the service and I do not work for the company's consortium.

At the end of the letter, the expert adds their name and contact information so that EAS can contact them if necessary.

After submitting the application for the service on the EAS website, **it is necessary to send your expert's written consent separately via email to the EAS** service project manager at ille.metsla@eas.ee.
